Push strollers for children

Handheld, personal-sized umbrellas



Not allowed in the Southern Cast Iron Cook-Off

Outside food and beverage

Pets

Glass

Personal tents, shade canopies or other shelters, shacks, sport-brellas, etc.

Beach or pole-style umbrellas

Cigarettes, Cigars, Pipes, AVPs, mods, liquid refills, vapes

Drones, inflatable items

Unauthorized promotional items

Athletic games, hula hoops, frisbees, kites, etc.

Bicycles

Large chairs with rocker, footrests, side tables, etc.

Other personal transport devices (e.g. skateboards, Segways, hoverboards, go-peds, etc.) Inserting stakes, poles, or any other objects into the ground, or use of ropes, cords, tape, etc. to reserve space

Video and audio recording equipment

Unauthorized vending or solicitation

Weapons, illicit drugs, and other contraband

Aerosol products - including sunscreen

Air horns

Kites

The Southern Cast Iron Cook-Off reserves the right to deny entry or remove from the event if anyone is in violation of these policies

Code of Conduct - These actions can get you removed from the Southern Cast Iron Cook-Off

Irresponsible or unsafe use of alcohol

Accessing restricted areas without proper credentials

Taunting, abusive, or offensive language

Obscene or offensive gestures, including the use of obscene or offensive gestures through imagery or symbolism including banners, signs, and other means of visual propaganda.

Possession/use/sale of illegal drugs

Public urination or defecation (outside of a proper and/or public restroom)

Fighting or engaging in any action that may harm, endanger, threaten, or bring discomfort to anyone

Damage, destruction, vandalism, or theft of any property

Participating in any activity that humiliates anyone or insults their human dignity

Fraudulently claiming a disability or abusing ADA services
